

40-DAYS WITH ISAIAH 58 – Undated Version

Cut out these cards to carry with you for easy reference and meditation throughout the day. The 14 verses of Isaiah 58 are split into manageable chunks to memorize for 40 days. Every week there is a blank “rest or review” card to take a break on Sundays or another day. In this case, the challenge will last slightly longer than 40 calendar days. You can also skip the review days and complete the challenge in 40 consecutive days.
